Accepted items include:

- Televisions
- Desktop PC
- Laptop PC
- Tablets
- Computer peripherals including:
 - Hard drives
 - Keyboards
 - Computer mice
 - Computer power supplies
 - Network and memory cards
 - Floppy disc and CD / DVD drives
- Printers
- Scanners
- Faxes

Items NOT Accepted on the day:

- Hazardous waste
- CRT's that have been removed from their cases or an encased CRT that is cracked or broken
- Batteries that are not an integral part of the system
- Refrigerators, washing machines and dryers
- Vacuum Cleaners
- Microwaves
- Other kitchen and household appliances
- Video and DVD players
- Hi-fi and stereo equipment
- Digital and video cameras
- Computer game consoles and accessories

No assistance will be available for transportation or unloading of vehicles at the sites and residents must remove and place items in the recycling bins as directed. There is also a limit of five (5) televisions per weekend. Small businesses and schools can also utilise the drop off days.

Infoactiv will collect e-waste from run council Techcollect events under the national scheme that's funded and run by the television and computer industry and regulated by the Australian Government under the Product Stewardship Act 2011 and the Product Stewardship (Televisions and Computers) Regulations 2011.
